

# "Fantasy Fish" – Sculpture

## Materials:

- Wood Base with hole (2mm wire)
- Powertex Black 500g & Red 500g
- Stone Art 250g
- Styrofoam Ball 50-60mm
- Styrofoam Ball 20mm
- Styrofoam Heart 60mm
- 2mm Galvanised Wire L:10cm
- Dusty Attic Shapes
- Toothpicks & dressmaking pins
- Large Pins & sequins for eyes
- Colourtrix: Bronze Gold or Silver
- Powercolour: Red, Ultramarine Blue, Titanium White...
- #12 Round paint brush & clay tool
- Latex Gloves & plastic bowl



## Instructions:

- Set up your workspace using "Tips for Beginning with Powertex"...
- STIR Powertex thoroughly before use... shake... pour into a plastic cup...
- Assemble Fish: place wire into the base, add styrofoam ball, use toothpicks to join the heart for the tail, cut 20mm styrofoam ball in 1/2 use 1/2 toothpick to add onto the ball for eyes
- Paint fish shape with Black Powertex.
- Mix Stone Art (Black & Red): follow instructions "About Stone Art"...
- Add Stone Art to create eyeballs press on with kebab stick. Allow to dry.
- Punch out the Dusty Attic shapes, lie on plastic wrap & paint with Black Powertex
- Paint reverse side of the Dusty Attic decorative shapes and place onto tail. Allow to dry.
- Add Fins: Use a dressmaking pin add fins to your fish with Powertex.
- Add Lips: Make 2 small coils of Red Stone Art clay, shape into lips & place on styrofoam ball
- Embellish your "Funky Fish" using Powercolour (mat) and Colourtrix (metallics) of choice. To do this: place a small amount of Colourtrix & Easy Varnish or Easycoat Glossy onto alfoil. Ensure your brush is dry, dip it into a small amount of Easy Varnish and use it to pick up some dry pigment, then lightly dry brush across the textures on your fish allowing some of the Powertex colour to come through...
